Standing Orders: Standing Orders allow the church to benefit from regular giving throughout the year even when members are unable to attend. If you would like to make your offerings by Standing Order, whether monthly, quarterly, six-monthly or annually, then please contact the Treasurer (contact details below) and we will be able to provide you with the details to set this up with your bank.

Internet Banking: Where members have internet banking, then payment can be made by BACS transfer instead of donating through Freewill Offering envelopes or via the open plate. The account details can be obtained from the Treasurer.

Freewill Offering Envelopes and Open Plate: Normally, these offerings can be made at Sunday services. However, if the buildings are closed please put your offerings aside until the buildings reopen.

Post: If you would like to make a donation by cheque then please mark it 'For the attention of the Treasurer' and send it to the address below.

Gift Aid: If you are a UK taxpayer, you can increase the value of your donation by completing a Gift Aid declaration. This will allow Banchory Ternan East to reclaim 25p for every £1 you donate. Please contact the Treasurer for the relative form.
