John in his gospel tells us that:

the brothers of Jesus did not believe in him. (John 7:5)

Luke tells us in the book of Acts that

the brothers of Jesus were present at the founding of the church (Acts 1:14)

Paul tells the church at Corinth in a letter that

Jesus appeared to James and then all the apostles.

Luke tells us in Acts that Peter said,

Tell this to James and then he left. (Acts 12:17)

The relationship between Jesus' brother James and God, the disciples and as the leader of the early church leader is an interesting one.
